



2018 Call for Proposals: Research Grants in Human Rights

The Minerva Center for Human Rights at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem invites researchers in Israel from social sciences, humanities, law, social work and education to submit applications for grants for research on topics related to human rights.

Applications may be submitted by researchers at any institution of higher learning in Israel who hold a PhD (priority will be given to researchers at the Hebrew University), and by PhD students at the Hebrew University who are already in the "second stage" (shlav bet).

<u>Size of available grants</u>: Up to 20,000 Shekels for researchers with PhD; up to 10,000 Shekels for PhD candidates

Grant period: January-December 2018

Deadline for Applications: January 14, 2018

Applications should include:

- 1. Research proposal (up to 3 pages, double space, in English)
- 2. Relevant bibliography
- 3. Timetable and budget estimates, noting the expenses for which the grant is requested
- 4. CV and list of publications
- 5. List of grants supporting the project and additional sources of funding that the researchers have applied to
