## To apply

- For applying grants use our Application Form – this is required (see web site).
- Note; the form is directed to English spoken applicants in Sweden belonging to a Swedish university or equivalent. Your application has to adapt to this. Please state your year of birth in the cell for personal identification nr or elsewhere.
- The application must be sent by traditional mail, not by registered letter. We do not accept e-mail or fax. (Make sure the application mail is delivered to our door. We have no capacity for collecting mail delivery outside our office. You can risk that the application will be returned without reaching us.)
- Note: the Application must be signed in origin as requested in application form.
- The project must be closed and reported within two years from the day the grants is paid out. The start of the project and requisition of the grant must be made within one years from the day the grant has been promoted.
- We accept overhead costs of maximum 20 %. This must be calculated in the amount applied for.
- Note: Personal stipend does not apply for other than Swedish residence.
- We give grants in the range of 100,000 – 500,000 SEK (in USD about 10,000 – 100,000).
- We prefer that projects is supported by other funding's as well – this shows a broader interest and quality of the project.
- The project must be connected (belonging) to a recognized university.

We hope you will manage to make your application with this guidelines. Apart from this information we have no capacity to answer more detailed questions. Thank you for your comprehension.
