In spite of Europe's political, social and economic turmoil Horizon 2020 is still the most well-endowed funding program that BGU researchers have access to. But there are strings attached – most of its programs are “top down” and the EC describes (in great detail) what it expects researchers to deliver, and the programs that are not “top down” are heavily oversubscribed (resulting in low success rates).

Together with the above since the start of Horizon 2020 (in 2014) BGU has received grants totaling more than €11 million.
