BSF – ECOLOGY

Starting from 2017, **Ecology** is moving to the Life Science year of the BSF cycle.

Therefore, and in order to avoid a 3 years gap, proposals in **Ecology** will be accepted in 2017, even though they were also part of the 2016 cycle year.

In addition **Ecology** will also include the sub-area "Ecology of Aquatic and Marine ecosystem", which was previously in **Oceanography**.

Please also note:

- Resubmission of 2016 proposals in Ecology and Marine Biology is allowed this year (only). However, we request that you contact the BSF office before opening a resubmission proposal to clear up some possible issues with our online submission system. - 2. The sub-areas of **Ecology** were redefined and expanded as follows:

3. Grantees in Ecology and Marine Ecology (previously submitted to Oceanography) from the 2014 submission year will be allowed to submit in 2017 (after 3 years, with the same PIs). If granted, the BSF will terminate the old grant and transfer the remaining funds to the new grant.
